

Pedro Salcedo, Bassoon (Colombia)

Born in Bogotá, Pedro Alejandro Salcedo won the position of Principal Bassoon of the Bogotá Philharmonic Orchestra in 2011.

He obtained the Magister in Bassoon from the Superior School of Music of Würzburg in Germany, under the guidance of Albrecht Holder. He did his undergraduate studies in Bogotá with Siegfried Miklin and in Weimar, Germany, with Frank Forst.

He has performed as a soloist with the main orchestras in Colombia, including the Bogotá Philharmonic, Medellín Philharmonic, Cali Philharmonic, EAFIT Symphony and Caldas Symphony.

At the same time, he has taught bassoon in the undergraduate and master's programs of the University of Antioquia, EAFIT University, Javeriana University and the University of the Andes.

For the Banco de la República Concert Hall, he recently recorded the Sonata for Bassoon and Piano by the Colombian composer Pedro Sarmiento.
